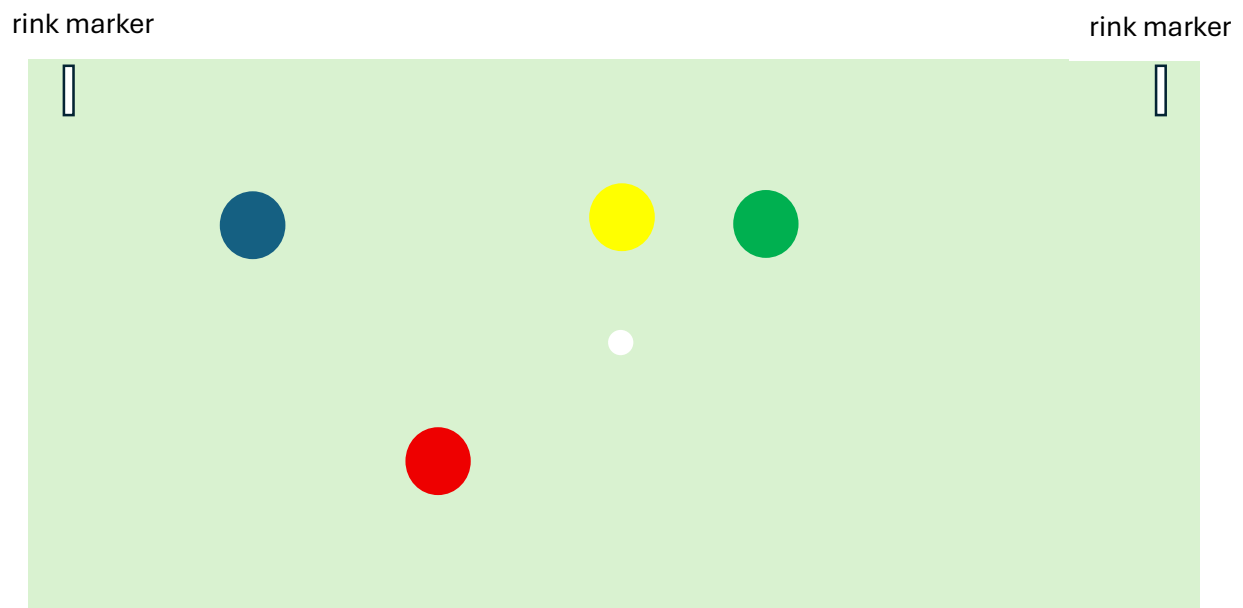


Indicating the distance of the wood from the jack

When you are on the mat it is very difficult to judge far in front (or behind) woods are from the jack. You rely on your skip (or N°2) to tell you. What they are indicating is the *perpendicular* distance from the jack, not the physical distance. This is to help you judge how much more (or less) weight to put into your delivery.

‘Jack high’ or a wave of the hand indicates you are level with the jack – you need to adjust the amount of ‘green’ (the angle you are bowling at).



The yellow bowl is ‘shot wood’ but they would all be indicated with the same distance.
